Vapross Inc Privacy Policy

Introduction

This privacy statement outlines our data collection policies and potential applications for the data we get from your use of our mobile applications, Vapross Inc, and other sources (together, the "Site and Services"). You agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy by using the Site and Services. You won't be able to use our site or services if you do not agree to the terms and conditions of this privacy statement, including having your personally identifiable information (or "Personal Information" as defined below) used in any of the methods outlined in this privacy statement. This privacy statement may occasionally be updated by our company at our sole discretion. Every time you use the site and services, it is your obligation to check the privacy policy for any updates because you are bound by them. You agree to and accept the Privacy Policy as changed if you continue to use the Site and Services after we post a revised privacy statement on our website.

This privacy statement is applicable to all Vapross Inc family products and services, including our print publications, web services, and other corporate offerings. Our Terms of Use and all other rules for using our site and services include this Privacy Policy.

Information Gathered

Vapross Inc gathers information on its users in a variety of ways, including voluntary submissions, participation in services made available through the Site and Services, information obtained from third parties with your permission, and through the use of cookies and other tracking technology. Our business gathers the following data:

Personal details

Information that identifies you individually, such as your name, phone number, email address, postal address, and perhaps details about particular support or customer service concerns, is referred to as "Personal Information." We frequently require this information in order to provide you with the services you have requested.

Cellular Telephones

You fully consent to and authorize us or a third party acting on our behalf to deliver autodialed or prerecorded telemarketers and/or text messages to the cellular phone number you supply by giving us your number. Although you are not obliged to agree to these calls in order to purchase any goods or services, doing so might restrict us from offering you some services. This authorization covers all upcoming text messages and autodialed or prerecorded telemarketing calls from us or a third party making these calls on our behalf. Texting STOP to (INSERT phone number) will work as a method of revoking your consent to receive texts at any moment.

Providing comments, ratings, and reviews

We gather data that you freely provide with us as part of our site and services, such as messages, posts, comments, responses, reviews, and ratings that you submit through the site and services ("User Generated Content"). Vapross Inc reserves the right to share your User Generated Content, such as your customer reviews, with third parties. You shouldn't submit User

Created Content if it contains information or Personal Information that you do not want shared in this way, or if you do not want particular information shared with others. We reserve the right to post User Generated Content that You have supplied in any format for public consumption.

Combined Information

We may gather broad, anonymous statistics on how people use the Site and Services, such as how many people visit a certain page on the Site, how long they remain there, and which links they click, if any. This data gives us and other third parties a general overview of our users, including their common viewing preferences, and enables us to change content, promotions, offers, and/or discounts on goods and services based on user traffic and behavior. We employ technologies like "cookies" and web beacons, which are covered in more detail below, to collect this data. We gather this data to assist improve the Site and Services and the user experience for visitors.

Outside Information

In order to verify or update your address, payment card, or other demographic and lifestyle information, we might add information from other sources to what you give us. We use this data to target our communications to you so that we can inform you of products, services, and offers that may be of interest to you, to help us maintain the accuracy of the data we collect, to fulfill our products and services, and for internal business analysis or other business goals consistent with our mission.

Cookies

Through the use of cookies, our company may automatically gather data and non-personally identifiable information. Cookies are tiny text files that websites use to identify returning visitors. make it easier for them to keep accessing the site, and make it easier for them to utilize the site. Cookies also enable websites to track user activity, gather data on how visitors use the site, and deliver advertisements and content accordingly. The majority of browsers provide you the option to manage cookies, including how to accept them or reject them. You can instruct your browsers to warn you whenever you receive a cookie or to prevent cookies entirely. Please be aware. though, that if you reject cookies, some parts of our site and services might not work or could work more slowly. As mentioned below, you might also receive cookies from our advertisers or other third parties that have links on the Site. These cookies are not under our immediate control. The Internet industry is accustomed to the usage of advertising cookies delivered by external ad servers. Through the use of technologies like cookies, we may enlist the assistance of third parties to gather and use anonymous data about your visits to and interactions with our website in order to tailor ads for goods and services. Additional Tracking Technology

Internet domain and host names, protocol (IP) addresses, browser software and operating system types, clickstream patterns, the MAC address or other technical data from your mobile device, location data through GPS, WiFi, Bluetooth, or comparable technologies, and the times and dates that our Site and Services are accessed are some examples of the information that tracking technologies may record. Every time you use your computer to browse the internet, your machine is given an IP address. Web servers, the devices that "serve up" webpages, utilize your computer's Internet address to identify it automatically. Tracer tag technology may also be used on the website and in the services. Other names for them include "Pixels," "Clear GIFs," and

"Web Beacons." We can learn about your website usage habits and other ways that you engage with our site and services thanks to this technology. These tracer tags aid in the optimization and customization of our website and services for you and other visitors. We could make connections between the data we gather through tracking technologies and your personal information.

Avoid Tracking

Users can disable tracking by websites and online services by using the Do Not Track (DNT) privacy preference in several web browsers. DNT is currently not recognized by Vapross Inc and the Site because the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) has not yet defined global standards for distinguishable DNT signals.

Information Usage

A number of uses are made of the data that Vapross Inc collects, including:

- To obtain reviews and ratings.

- To enhance the Website and Services and also maximize third-party product and/or service offers.

- For our marketing efforts and the marketing of discounts offered through our Site and Services by service providers.

Disclosures and Transfers of Information

We do not share Personal Information with other parties unless any of the following requirements are met:

- We have your consent to disclose the information.
- The disclosure is necessary for the purpose for which the personal information was obtained:
- The disclosure is to the service provider from whom you purchased services through our company platform;
- The disclosure is to financial service vendors in order to complete and carry out your request for the acquisition and delivery of products and services.
- The disclosure is permitted by relevant law;
- The Private Information to be provided is otherwise publicly accessible under relevant law:
- The disclosure is connected to the sale or other disposal of all or a portion of our business or assets;
- The disclosure is for our own marketing purposes (including, without limitation, for Vapross Inc to market services to you on third-party social media platforms such as Facebook), or, by using your permission, for third-party marketing reasons;

Minors

Our company, Vapross Inc, is not intended for individuals who are under the age of 13. We do not allow anyone under the age of 13 to provide any information on our website. We do not knowingly

collect personal information from children who are under 13 years old. If you are under the age of 13, please do not use or provide any information on our website or its features, including registering on our website, making purchases through our website, using any interactive or public comment features, or providing any personal information such as your name, address, telephone number, email address, screen name or username. If we discover that we have collected personal information from a child under 13 years old without verified parental consent, we will delete that information immediately. Information Transfers and Disclosures

Except in the instances where one or more of the following circumstances apply, we do not release Personal Information to third parties:

The disclosure is made to the service provider from whom you purchased services through our company platform. The disclosure is given to banking service suppliers in order to complete and carry out your request for the acquisition and delivery of products and services. The disclosure is permitted by applicable law and we have your permission to make the disclosure.

- The disclosed party either controls, is under the control of, or has mutual influence with our firm.
- The disclosure is combined with information obtained from other companies and utilized to enhance and tailor services, content, and advertising from us or third parties. If we determine in our sole discretion that disclosing information about users who we suspect of engaging in illegal activity—even in the absence of a subpoena, warrant, or court order—is necessary for the establishment or maintenance of legal claims or legal compliance, to satisfy any law, regulation, subpoena, government request, or in connection with litigation, we will disclose that information.
- The disclosure is to third parties who work on our behalf to maintain our Site and Services, mail lists, process orders and deliver goods and services, send postal mail, handle claims for lost or stolen certificates, provide marketing support, verify your identity for review integrity, and analyze data (collectively "Administrative Service Providers"). Administrative Service Providers may be located anywhere in the world.

Agreements are made between Vapross Inc and the outside parties to whom we are transferring data to ensure the permitted use and security of the transferred information in compliance with this Privacy Policy and applicable legislation prior to the sharing of your Personal Information with others. If Vapross Inc learns that one of these outside parties is using or disclosing Personal Information inappropriately, it will make the outside party aware and ask it to take reasonable action to stop.

We might offer certain Personal Information to others as a service for their marketing needs. When you submit User Generated Content pertaining to certain Service Providers, we might also share your name and address with those Service Providers. We shall stop disclosing your personal information if you correctly notify us that you no longer want us to do so. Except as expressly provided in this Privacy Policy, we do not directly control the third parties with whom we disclose such Personal Information, so if you would like them to stop using your Personal Information, you will need to contact them directly.

We may also provide aggregate visitor information to our current or potential business partners, other third parties, or the government in order to characterize how the Site and Services are used. In order to provide tailored information, promotions, offers, and/or discounts on goods and services, we may also share aggregated demographic and preference data with third parties.

Access, Security, and Integrity of Data

We store the Personal Information you give us and that we collect in databases that we directly manage or that we have access to through our administrative service providers. We use security measures that are appropriate for the sensitivity of the Personal Information and consistent with industry standards, including physical, organizational, and technological safeguards, like firewalls, to protect your Personal Information as we deem necessary and as required by the applicable law. We cannot, however, guarantee the confidentiality of our databases or that the information you submit won't be intercepted while being sent to us over the Internet because no security mechanism is impenetrable.

Only employees of our company, our third-party service providers who need access to your personal information to offer the aforementioned services to you, and anyone else you have given us permission to share your information with will be able to access it.

We only keep personal data we gather for as long as it is actually necessary to achieve the goals for which it was obtained or to otherwise comply with legal obligations.

Your information might be moved to and kept on computers in states, provinces, or other countries where the privacy rules might not be as strict as those where you reside. Please be advised that if you choose to provide us with information while residing outside of the United States, we will move, process, and retain your Personal Information there. As a result, in accordance with U.S. law, access requests to this information may come from governments, courts, law enforcement officers, and national security agencies there. We shall make a reasonable effort, within the bounds of the applicable legislation, to ensure that the Personal Information continues to be protected. You agree that your personal information may be transferred to, processed, and stored in the United States by providing it. As part of your participation and access to the Site and Services, we could give you a user ID and password. Only you and your family members are allowed to use your user ID and password. Your user ID and password are confidential, and you are solely responsible for keeping them secure. You may not divulge your user ID and password to anyone else. You alone are entirely accountable for all actions taken with your user ID and password.

Credit Card Details

In order to charge you for our service, we might divulge credit card information to dependable outside parties. To process your orders and payments or to verify your stored credit card information, we employ third parties for secure credit card transaction processing. As a result, we communicate billing information to these third parties.

Your information is safeguarded by our credit card processing partners' security protocols both during and after the transaction. Vendors that process credit cards have received certification for conformity with a number of frameworks recognized as industry standards, including the SSAE-16 audit standard and Payment Card Industry (PCI) Service Provider Level 1.
